Final Written and Oral Exam:

The written exam includes exercises designed to assess listening, reading and writing skills as well as basic grammar and vocabulary. The written exam includes the following sections:

- Listening comprehension
- Reading comprehension
- Use of Spanish
- Text composition

The oral exam consists of review questions covering the main topics studied during the course.

Assessment for attending/non-attending students is the same since this is a course of no obligatory attendance.
