Sintesi contenuti	The course illustrates aspects of scientific dissemination in institutional settings and public engagement, with particular attention to social participation, democratisation of science and knowledge transfer.

Argomenti dell'insegnamento	The course is intended as a follow-up, adopting an applied approach, to previous courses on techniques and tools for documenting and disseminating the research activities. The course will take place mainly in a laboratory form, with the aim of supporting students to develop the dissemination and public engagement aspects of their phd projects. The lecturer(s) will use examples from their ongoing research/professional projects in order to share common issues and engage problem-solving and discussion.
