Lernergebnisse (zusätzliche Informationen)	Specific educational objective of the course is the acquisition of basic knowledge and competences of the development of the Italian economic constitution in the European context on the basis of an interdisciplinary approach. The first part deals with the economic theory of regulation. The second part analyses several areas and ways of State intervention in the economy also with respect to the increasing European legislation, in order to assess the costs and benefits of the intervention.  The professional competences of the course are integrated with the curriculum of the degree course in Economics, Politics and
	Ethics and are devoted to the qualification of the various forms of State intervention in the economy from a legal perspective for the purpose of the understanding the respective legal institutes.
Art der Prüfung	For attending and non-attending students: the exam is written; students must answer 3 out of 4 questions (ILOs assessed: 1-5).
