Assessment	The exam assesses whether students have achieved the aforementioned objectives. The final grade is based on a final colloquium and an intermediate practical assignment.
Evaluation Criteria	A single final grade is assigned. The final examination will assess the following: Correctness of arguments, clear argument, critical analysis skills, processing and reflection skills, Latin language skills. In the event of a negative assessment of the overall module, any positively assessed parts of the module will be counted towards the next module examination. Please note, however, that a negative assessment will also be included in the count of examination attempts in this case. According to the examination regulations, three attempts without passing will result in a block for three examination dates. (see also Article 6, Paragraph 4 of the current examination regulations).
