Sintesi contenuti	<p>The students acquire fundamental theoretical-methodological and practical-methodical knowledge in qualitative educational and social research. The course covers methods of empirical data collection as well as various approaches to analysis and interpretation. These methods are not only introduced, but also practically applied by the students. The selection of methods is</p>

	<p>guided by their relevance to the professional practice of social educators. In addition, students train to read empirical studies and critically assess their quality, to take research ethics standards into account, to engage in well-founded methodological reflection, and to develop their own research design.</p>
