Sintesi contenuti	The course introduces students to the theory and practice of the moving image as a creative medium. Teaching adopts a conceptual and experimental approach with a focus on different contexts of publication and use.

dell'insegnamento	<p>In this course, students produce individual documentary videos in the context of a given common thematic framework. All relevant phases of professional video production from the conception, handling of camera- light- and sound technology, image- and sound design as well as montage and storytelling methods are taught in the course and practiced in exemplary exercises.</p> <p>SS - Course held by Georg Zeller:</p> <p>The course provides comprehensive instruction in the development, creation, and execution of small video projects, with a focus on documentary filmmaking. Topics covered include the research and writing process, filming techniques, lighting and sound recording, as well as editing, montage, and post-production.</p>
