Contents Summary	<p>This is a module of the basic training area and serves the function of orientation and initial knowledge of educational contexts and related teaching methodologies.</p> <p>The module introduces the theoretical-methodological foundations of general didactics with particular reference to first and second grade secondary schools. It accompanies students to get to know, understand, experience and reflect on: (a) the complexity and quality of educational contexts and relationships; (b) educational projects and processes; (c) the specificity and importance of the educational profession; (d) the importance of the learning</p>

	environment and the role of experience in the teaching-learning process.
