<b>Obiettivi formativi specifici e risultati di apprendimento attesi</b>	<p>Knowledge and understanding:</p> <p>By the end of the programme, students will have acquired the following knowledge and skills:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. analyse the demand and supply of goods and services;</li> <li>2. the ability to understand the price mechanism in market economies;</li> <li>3. the ability to apply the concepts of game theory to the economic behaviour of public and private actors;</li> <li>4. the ability to understand the role of governments in market economies;</li> <li>5. the ability to analyse the behaviour of economic variables in the short, medium and long run;</li> <li>6. the ability to place economic thinking in a historical context and to assess the role of technology and social change in the development of economic thinking;</li> <li>7. the ability to understand complex texts in the field of economics in the three languages of instruction;</li> <li>8. the ability to analyse human behaviour in organisations;</li> <li>9. the ability to understand theories of organisational decision-making;</li> <li>10. the ability to understand how political decisions are made and how these decisions affect the economy;</li> <li>11. recognising and understanding the conditions required for sustainable economic development, taking into account the environment and natural resources;</li> <li>12. understand the reasons for economic growth and development of countries;</li> <li>13. understand the basic principles of the functioning of labour markets;</li> <li>14. estimation and interpretation of econometric models for the empirical analysis of the above problems.</li> </ol>

<b>Modalità di esame</b>	<p>The written exam tests competence in reading, writing, vocabulary and grammar. The examination covers a text and topic that has been discussed in class. Duration of the written examination maximum 90 minutes.</p> <p>The oral examination will consist in a brief discussion on the written exam (ca. 10-15 minutes).</p>
<b>Criteri di valutazione</b>	<p>Final examination</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 50% written exam</li> <li>• 50% oral examination</li> </ul> <p>Evaluation criteria are clarity of answers, mastery and correctness of language according to the level B2/C1, ability to summarize, evaluate, and establish relationships between topics.</p>
