Inhaltsangabe	The course introduces the study of the organisation and functioning of the public administration and mainly covers the following topics: the national and European system of legal sources; the government and organisation of the State's administrative bodies; independent administrative authorities and their role in the regulation of national public services; the principles governing administrative activity; administrative acts and

	measures; the administrative procedure; forms of legal protection against unlawful administrative action.

Bewertungskriterien	<ul> <li>(i) Final written examination consisting of 10 multiple-choice questions and 3 open-ended questions (to be chosen out of 4).</li> <li>(ii) Alternatively for attending students:</li> <li>1. written mid-term which will weigh 33% of the final grade (30 multiple-choice/closed-ended questions) on the first 6 lectures of the programme.</li> <li>2. final written exam which will weigh 67% of the final grade (6 multiple choice questions and 2 open-ended questions to be chosen out of 3) on the remaining lessons 7-18 of the programme.</li> <li>3. active participation in the exercises or writing a short paper (up to 2 points).</li> </ul>
	For the assessment of the open-ended questions, the following will be relevant: clarity of the answer; language property (appropriateness in legal, grammatical and logical terms); ability to summarise, evaluate and make connections between topics.
