He graduated in 1998 from the “**School of Photography**” in Vienna and earned his diploma with highest honors in **Cinematography** at ZeLIG – School for Television and Film in Bolzano in 2001.

In the same year, he co-founded **helios.bz**, an audiovisual communication agency, and has since worked as a photographer and filmmaker. His documentaries focus on social and environmental issues and have taken him around the world.

Martin participated in the RIFF (Reykjavík International Film Festival, 2009), the **Berlinale Talent Campus** (2008), and the **ESoDoc** documentary training initiative (2008). From the very beginning, he has been actively involved with **FAS** (Film Association of South Tyrol), serving on its board from 2007 to 2014, and playing a key role in the establishment of the South Tyrol Film Commission.

In 2012, together with long-time partners Patrick Kofler, Mauro Podini, and Günther Innerebner, he founded the independent production company **Helios Sustainable Films**, which develops and co-produces documentaries and feature films for the international market. Martin Rattini is the CEO of Helios Sustainable Films.

In 2018, he won a golden LOLA at the **German Film Awards** as Best Producer in the Children’s Film category for the film “Amelie Rennt”, which premiered at the Berlinale and won numerous awards at international festivals.

In 2023, he was selected as a producer participant at the prestigious **EAVE** workshop in Luxembourg.

Since then, Martin has been a member of the **German and European Film Academy**.
